#### Disaster Preparedness

On November 29th an EF3 tornado swept thru the Danville, Neel, and Pumpkin Center areas of north Alabama damaging homes and businesses. Post 15 personnel rosters were immediately reviewed and it was determined that 17 members resided in the areas affected by the tornado.

On November 30th and December 1st steps were taken to determine the extent of damage, if any, to residences of Post 15 members. Of the 17 members, 9 were contacted by telephone. In that attempts to contact the remaining 8 members by telephone were unsuccessful, those addresses were driven to and the residences were inspected for damage. Fortunately, none of the 17 Post 15 residences were found to be damaged.

This action was taken to assist Post 15 members in obtaining financial assistance as made available by the American Legion National Emergency Fund (NEF), if needed. This fund provides financial assistance of up to \$3,000, as needed, for food, clothing, and lodging to members who had to evacuate their primary residences due to a disaster. Also, some emergency supplies could be made available by Post 15 disaster personnel at that time.

As a follow-up to the above activity, it was found that actions to determine if Post 15 members' residences had received damage by the tornado consumed a lot of time. Time that could, in the future, be used to assist those who need help. Post 15 members that reside in disaster areas could help this process greatly by calling the Disaster Chairman (George Marsh 256-345-0777) or the Commander (Roger Groves 256-606-4476) and report if any damage has occurred.
