

In the past I have only required this for Officers. Due to audits being conducted by the IRS at some Post, we are now being advised to keep all our membership applications and make attempts to obtain DD214s. Members that do not have this document (Active Duty less than 90 days) will need to provide me with orders of active duty service during the time periods for eligibility. I will be glad to assist any member obtain these documents. Members may also black out information that is not needed for membership and SS numbers. These files will be kept in a locked and secure file.
